Recordkeeping

If company also offers noncertified services, all EcoWise Certified service records must be kept separate or otherwise immediately identifiable. (Section 103.2)

Keep record for at least 3 yrs. (Section 103.3)

An EcoWise Certified IPM Practitioner must conduct the initial site visit

(Sections 101.3 & 300.5)

Thoroughly inspect property and ID the pest(s). (Section 101.3)

Record the following:

- •Pest name, locations, number/extent of damage
- Conducive conditions
- •Habitat modifications/pest proofing/sanitation needed



Discuss findings with customer: pest/problem, location, and severity (Section 101.4)

Discuss responsibilities of PMP & Customer (Section 101.5)

Discuss pest tolerance levels with customer (Section 101.5)

Discuss options for management, recommended treatments and possible outcomes (Section 101.5)

Provide the customer with a list of non-chemical and chemical tools that may be used (company's **IPM Toolbox**) (Section 102.2)



Provide information to customer about EcoWise Certified & IPM (Section 101.6)



Certified IPM Practitioner must develop a written, site-specific IPM plan that integrates a number of treatment strategies. (Section 101.7 & 300.5)



A Certified IPM Practitioner must implement or directly oversee the implementation of the IPM plan. (Section 101.6 & 300.5)
